**Subject:** **Item 9: Presentation of the Los Cerritos Wetlands Stewardship Program Vision Plan.**

**BACKGROUND:** The Los Cerritos Wetlands Authority's (LCWA) Stewardship Program has been working to enhance and restore 12-acres around Zedler Marsh since 2009. This project has proven to be a very successful community-based restoration effort. The LCWA's Stewardship Program is exploring other portions of LCWA land holdings that could be improved through community involvement. Therefore, a Vision Plan was developed to help visualize where additional stewardship projects could take place and what they could look like. This presentation will share highlights of the Vision Plan.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The development of the Los Cerritos Wetlands Stewardship Program Vision Plan was funded by a grant from Proposition 84 via the Rivers and Mountains Conservancy. (Workplan Item: LCWA 14002)
