 - a. As a response to increased trespassing Tidal Influence staff has updated southern gate entrance security to prevent trespassing.

- 14. Trails
 - a. The stewardship trail system used during maintenance activities and stewardship events has become overgrown and erosion has occurred in portions of the trail.

<u>Tidal Influence staff will monitor the vegetative growth and erosion. An assessment and maintenance actions will be scheduled in the coming months as stewardship programs resume to ensure visitor safety.</u>

 - a. On the morning of June 24th Tidal Influence staff was informed of a break in at our Hellman equipment storage facility. The facility was found left open with damaged locks, and missing valuables. A breach was found in the fence line shared with the electronic entrance gate. After contacting local authorities Tidal influence staff has repaired the breached fence line and resecured the facility.

<u>Tidal Influence staff has held a security meeting and are actively working to implement new security updates on the property to prevent another incident from occurring.</u>

We recommend LCWA staff meet with LA County to determine a new approach to secure this property. We recommend adjusting the fence line location to provide a thoroughfare along the levee path.

- 21. Homeless -
 - In April trash bags containing various items were found on site with native vegetation pulled out and used as cover for the bags. Concurrent with the latest encampment clean up Tidal influence staff removed and disposed of the bags.
 Trash bags were once again found hidden under the removed vegetation.

<u>Tidal Influence staff will dispose of the trash in the coming months and continue to monitor the vegetative recovery of the site.</u>

 - a. The stewardship trail system used during maintenance activities and stewardship events has become overgrown and erosion has occurred in portions of the trail.

<u>Tidal Influence staff has conducted vegetative maintenance along the trails system. To ensure visitor safety Tidal</u>
Influence staff will continue to monitor trail conditions as stewardship programs continue.

- b. In order to better understand effects of urbanization on small mammal communities CSULB's Mammal Lab requested to install wildlife cameras and small mammal traps in 2 different locations along Los Cerritos Wetland's Hellman Trail system. Prior to installation, Tidal Influence staff met with the researchers to ensure no biological resources would be impacted. The installation and small mammal surveys took place from July 15th to July 18th with the cameras set to be retrieved after a 30 day period.

We recommend LCWA staff meet with LA County to determine a new approach to secure this property. We recommend adjusting the fence line location to provide a thoroughfare along the levee path.

 - a. Fence breaches have been found in four locations along eastern fence line (See Photos)
 - i. South corner of property.
 - ii. Eastern fence line near levee gates.

The breaches in the South corner of the property and Eastern fence line near the levee gates have been repaired. <u>Tidal Influence staff will continue to monitor the condition of the fence line and conduct repairs in the coming months.</u>

- 21. Homeless
 - a. A new encampment was established along a breached portion of the Eastern fence line. Tidal Influence staff and the LCWA homeless contractor coordinated with local authorities to remediate the encampment.
 - b. Trash bags containing various items were found on site with native vegetation pulled out and used as cover for the bags. Tidal Influence staff removed the trash and will continue to monitor the vegetative recovery of the site in the coming months.
