Hellman

- 1. Gates OK

 - a. Rutting out of SLCW trail near the Gum Grove gate due to recent rains. (See Photos)
 - *i.* <u>Tidal Influence staff will conduct trail maintenance through the upcoming months to ensure safe access.</u> Nonnative Vegetation is growing along the SLCW trail. (See Photos)
 - *i.* <u>Tidal Influence and Conservation Core of Long Beach staff will conduct trail maintenance through the</u> upcoming months to ensure access.

- a. Tidal Influence staff removed 8 bike ramps along northeast roads. Staff will continue to monitor for non-beneficial use. (See Photos)

 - a. 4 breaches were found along the east fence line, exposing the parcel to the bike path. (See Photos)
 - *i.* <u>Tidal Influence staff will not make additional repairs until the issue with the levee gates is resolved.</u>

- c. A fire pit with a gas container was found near the bike ramps, on northeast side of property. (See Photos)
 - *i.* <u>Tidal Influence will contact Signal Hill Petroleum to give notice of the fire hazard and continue to monitor</u> <u>the area for non-beneficial use.</u>
